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with signs of life, healthcare providers should begin CPR unless they can definitely palpate a pulse within 10 s [3••].

For infants, use your mouth to make a complete seal over the infant's mouth and nose, then blow in for one second to make the chest clearly rise. Now, deliver two rescue breaths. Begin CPR. If the child or baby is unresponsive to the rescue breaths, begin CPR.

Different Respiratory Rates during Resuscitation in a ...

ABG (Normal): pH: 7.35-7.45. PaO₂: 80-100 mmHg. PaCO₂: 35-45 mmHg. HCO₃: 22-26 mEq/L. O₂ sat: 95-100% (on room air) BE +/- 1. Lowest acceptable SBP for patients older than 1 yr = 70+ (2 x age in years) Cardiac arrest in the pediatric patient is also commonly due to progressive shock.

PALS Algorithms 2020 (Pediatric Advanced Life Support)

A respiratory rate of 20 to 30 breaths per minute is new for infants and children who are (a) receiving CPR with an advanced airway in place or (b) receiving rescue breathing and have a pulse. 1

Two Issues With the New PALS Guidelines | EMS World

This equates to approximately 1.5 inches (4 cm) in infants to 2 inches (5 cm) in children (Class IIa, LOE C-LD). Once children have reached puberty, the recommended adult compression depth of at least 5 cm, but no more than 6 cm, is used for the adolescent of average adult size (Class I, LOE C-LD). 16.

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
